2025 Nominations for ACIFA Executive Council



During the ACIFA Annual General Meeting on May 13th, 2025 at Banff Springs, three positions on the ACIFA Executive council will be open for election:

Vice-President Internal - The Vice-President Internal shall:

- a. assume the role of the President of the Association should the President be unable to fulfil the duties of the President's Office;
- b. report to the Executive Council as directed;
- c. be empowered to countersign cheques;
- d. provide a brief written summary of their activities in advance of each official Presidents' Council meeting; and
- e. assume the role of Chair of the Presidents' Council at the request of the President.

Vice-President Professional Affairs - The Vice-President: Professional Affairs shall:

- a. chair the Professional Affairs Committee;
- b. provide a brief written summary of their activities in advance of each official Presidents' Council meeting;
- c. fulfil such other duties and responsibilities as are assigned by the President; and
- d. present an annual report to the Association.

Vice-President Finance and Records - The Vice-President Finance and Records shall

- a. be responsible for maintaining complete official records of ACIFA;
- b. ensure custody of minute books and records, which are to be made available for inspection by members on reasonable notice;
- arrange facilities for and ensure preparation and circulation of Agendas,
 Minutes and Notices of Motion for all Association Assemblies and meetings;
- d. report to the Executive Council as directed;
- e. be empowered to countersign cheques;
- f. administer the financial affairs of the ACIFA, as directed by the Executive Council and as restricted by the budget;
- g. at the Annual General Meeting, propose a budget for the following fiscal year;
- at the Annual General Meeting, present an annual report that includes an audited financial statement, by a qualified auditor, for the fiscal year ending June 30;
- i. ensure custody of the corporate seal that is used to execute legaldocuments of the Association; and
- J. provide a brief written summary of their activities in advance of each official Presidents' Council meeting.


